



40&8 Scholarship Procedure

Our 40/8 Local organizations establish and administrate their scholarship program. Each Local program generates its program requirements. The Boland fund is our national program. (The starting point is the same for both programs).

Locale Program

The starting point begins with our Local Organization called a Voiture Group/Locale).

- (1) You will go to our 40/8 website and locate the resource App.
- (2) You will select the Grande Officers App; find the state of your choice and the chosen Grande Correspondent.
- (3) Using their profile information, you will contact them for the nearest Locale group to your resident.
- (4) Once contact you will request the Locale Correspondent/Nurses Training Director for program details and request candidate consideration, ask for any scholarship application and submit per instructions.
- (5) The candidate must be a wholeheartedly second-year student in an Accredited Register Nurse curriculum and meet all application requirements.

Boland Program

The National Committee manages and supervises the Boland Fund Undergraduate/Advance Degree program, but the starting point is the same as the Locale program.

** Repeat steps 1-5 from above

- (6) A candidate is recommended by a Voiture Group and submitted to the Grande for review
- (7) A Boland application form mail/e-mail to the prospective candidate for completion and submittal
- (8) Boland Committee will review, determine eligibility and submit to the candidate an acknowledgment letter.
